## ZARAGOZA

### *and El Pilar*

We will leave Hotel Montagut in Santa Susanna towards the city of Madrid, but we will make a stop in the city of Zaragoza which will be enjoying its Fiesta Mayor that weekend. The Fiestas del Pilar are the patron saint festivities of the city that are celebrated in honor of the Virgen of Pilar.

In 1980, they were declared Celebrations of National Tourist Interest.

## MADRID

### *A vital, welcoming and cosmopolitan city*

The capital of Spain offers a comfortable and safe setting where you can indulge in leisure, art, and adventure. Its rich artistic and natural heritage, its advanced transportation network, its excellent cuisine, and the passion with which the residents of Madrid enjoy day and night make it one of the most attractive cities in the world.

Attractions such as the Puerta de Alcalá, the Cibeles and Neptune fountains, the Reina Sofía, El Prado, and Thyssen museums, among others, the Plaza Real, the Almudena Cathedral, and the Royal Palace and its green spaces such as the Retiro Park await us to enjoy everything that this beautiful city has ready for us.

## SEGOVIA

In 1985, UNESCO included the city of Segovia and its Roman aqueduct on its list of Heritage Cities. Reasons were not lacking because the beauty of its enclave, its surroundings, its buildings, trees, and streets justify this decision.

Unique and magnificent, the Aqueduct of Segovia is one of the most superb works that the Romans left scattered throughout their vast empire. It was built to carry the water from the Sierra to Segovia, and it is a heraldic symbol of the city, along with its roasted suckling pig.

## ÁVILA

ÁVILA is the city where heritage, history, and art, cuisine, celebration, and mysticism, culture, and nature meet. ÁVILA is a medieval city of the three cultures, of World Heritage, of the Network of Jewish Quarters.

Walls, houses, palaces, temples, and convents make up the rich artistic heritage of the city, the result of an enriching historical past led by the cultures that lived there together.

## ITINERARY

### *Sunday, October 13th*

We will leave after breakfast by bus to Madrid. Half way we will stop in Zaragoza to visit the Basilica of Pilar, right for the Celebration of the patron saint of Zaragoza.

We will arrive to Madrid to have dinner and rest to recover strength for the cities that we have yet to visit.

### *Monday, October 14th*

We will visit Madrid, the Royal Palace, its gardens, the Santa María Real de la Almudena Cathedral, the Plaza del Sol and its shopping area, taking the opportunity to have lunch at any of its restaurants.

In the afternoon, we will visit the Prado Museum, the most visited in Spain with its permanent collections from Velázquez, Goya, and El Bosco, among others.

The proximity of the museum to Cibeles, the Puerta de Alcalá, and the Retiro Park ensures an intense and incredibly productive day.


