In the year 713 AD the city fell into Muslim hands and was reconquered by the Christian troops of Alfonso IX of Leon in 1230. Great history awaits us in this city.

- Single Occupancy - 1800 € (one thousand eight hundred euros)

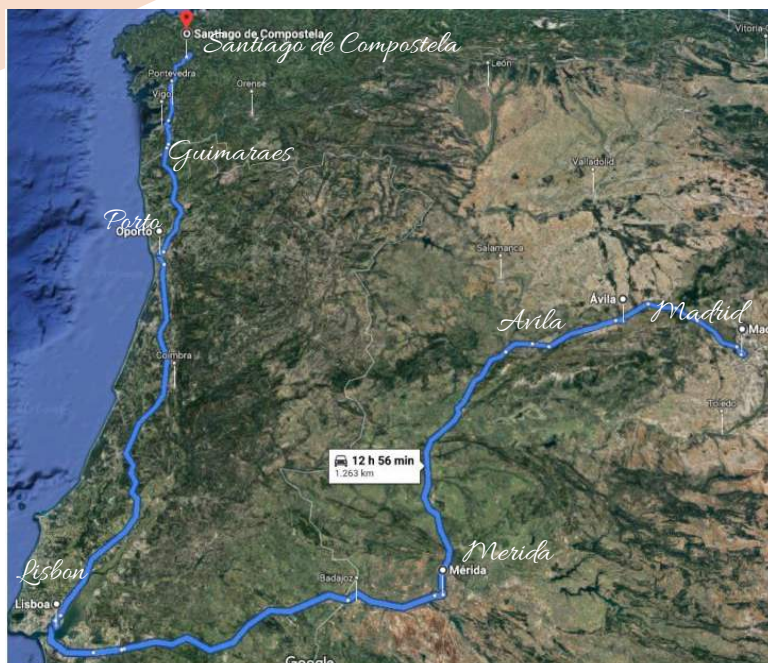
REGISTRATION FEE - GROUPS OF 30 TO 50 PARTICIPANTS
