## GIRONA

### SATURDAY 23 OCTOBER TOUR

Girona is a city with the tranquility of a small town, but with the appeal of the big cities. Take a quiet stroll through the historic center, visit its monuments and museums, comfortably walk its streets and squares.

With a rich history, Girona allows you to travel through more than two thousand years of history from two fortified enclosures: the Força Vella and the Medieval Quarter. The first corresponds to its Roman foundation, and the second to the expansion of its walls during the 14th and 15th centuries. The numerous monuments that have survived until today, preserve remarkable artistic features.

The beauty of Girona is topped off by the intriguing Jewish quarter, the beautiful streets, porticoed squares, the exultant Baroque spaces, and the nineteenth-century buildings by Rafael Masó.

The city with the best preserved Jewish district in Europe, the city where "El Perfume" was filmed, and legend has it that "you can only go back to Girona if you have kissed the bottom of the lioness."

It is one of the first things we will do as soon as we arrive... **you will definitely want to return!**



## ITINERARY

This tour has been planned for those groups that arrive on Friday 22 October, stay at our hotel in Santa Susanna, have dinner in the same hotel before getting some rest and head off first thing Saturday morning after an abundant breakfast.

We will depart at 9:30 am to Girona with a 90 minute journey, to enjoy its history, shops, squares, staircases, and the great Cathedral with one of the largest naves in Europe.

At noon you can have lunch at any of its picturesque restaurants, visit the city walls, the gardens, or "El Call" (Jewish neighborhood), and do some shopping.

By 6:00 pm we will return to the hotel for dinner and to enjoy hotel entertainment. A complete day!

# TARRAGONA

## SUNDAY 24 OCTOBER TOUR

Declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 2000, its location on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea on the Costa Dorada, its warm water beaches, as well as its recreation centers, historical tradition and artistic heritage, makes it a top tourist destination.

Its origin dates back to the ancient Roman Tarraco, with more than 1500 years of history. The "Tarraco Archaeological Site" has made Tarragona a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.

Tarraco (Tarragona) was an ancient Roman city and during the Empire it was one of the main cities of Hispania.

On the shores of the Mediterranean you will find the Roman Amphitheater and the City Walls, Roman Temples, the Cathedral, and the incredible Roman Circus, among many other attractions.

A city full of history.

## ITINERARY

This tour has been planned for those groups that arrive on Friday 22 or Saturday 23 October and stay at our hotel in Santa Susanna.

We will depart at 9:00 am, after breakfast to visit the City Walls, the Roman Circus, the Cathedral or a ride in the touristic train.

We will see the Roman Amphitheater and we can have lunch at La Pla de la Seu (former City Hall) on one of the patios of its many restaurants.

Later we can visit the Rambla Nova and have a coffee on the Mediterranean balcony and enjoy spectacular panoramic views of the sea.

We will return at 6:00 pm to the hotel, to have dinner and rest.



# Costs

## FROM FRIDAY 22 OCTOBER

For those arriving on Friday 22 October, the tour fee includes:

- 4-meal plan (dinner for Friday 22, Saturday 23 and Sunday 24 plus lunch on Monday 25 October).
- Two lunches for the tours on Saturday to Girona and Sunday to Tarragona (a sandwich, water, and fruit)
- Transportation on air conditioned coach booked by the organization.
- Accommodations (3 nights) with breakfast:
  - Quadruple Occupancy 210 €
  - Triple Occupancy 235 €
  - Double Occupancy 260 €
  - Single Occupancy 320 €

## FROM SATURDAY 23 OCTOBER

For those arriving on Saturday 23 October the tour fee includes:

- 3-meal plan (dinner for Saturday 23 and Sunday 24 plus lunch on Monday 25 October)
- Lunch for the tour on Sunday 24 to Tarragona (a sandwich, water, and fruit)
- Transportation on air conditioned coach booked by the organization
- Accommodations (2 nights) with breakfast:
  - Quadruple Occupancy 140 €
  - Triple Occupancy 160 €
  - Double Occupancy 180 €
  - Single Occupancy 220 €

These prices are per person and in euros. Includes the aforementioned services, the tour production, and the staff that will accompany the group during the whole journey.

The tours are for a minimum of 30 people and must be confirmed by 15 September 2021.
